Wild race through Philly coming May 3

Looking for adventure mixed with a physical and mental challenge? Here's your chance. The fifth annual CityChase, billed as the world's largest urban adventure series, will come to Philadelphia on May 3.

More than 350 teams of two are expected in the city. They must make their way through an obstacle course and scavenger hunt, working from a clue sheet detailing ChasePoints, which are a variety of physical and intellectual challenges throughout the city, sometimes with a humorous twist.

They are also given a pass to ride mass-transit bus and subway lines.

The first team to win 10 ChasePoints and cross the finish line advances to the National Championships which will be held in a secret location. The winner of that contest will represent Team USA at the 2008 World Championships, also at an undisclosed location. To register, visit www.citychase.com

Participants will rediscover the city and perhaps themselves while earning ChasePoints by completing a variety of tasks, including cleaning local parks, painting classrooms and dancing in public for charitable donations.
